Hardwood is a product of nature and can act in ways beyond human control. Hardwood has variation in its color and open grain. These characteristics in the wood add their own unique touch to each piece of solid hardwood furniture

Proper care will ensure years of enjoyment with your new furniture:

 Maintain a humidity-controlled environment (in the 35-45% range) to prevent warping and cracking.

 Keep your furniture out of continued direct sunlight and away from direct heat sources.

 Use coasters/trivets with nonscratching bottoms to avoid scratches.

 Avoid spilling or using harsh solvents such as nail polish remover and many cleaning products.

 Dust often and carefully with a soft cloth - following the grain pattern.

• Do use a mild, non-alkaline soap and water applied to a soft cloth or sponge – periodically, to clean surface. Immediately dry with a soft cloth and follow wood grain.

 Avoid any wood polish that contains any silicones.
